Medical Malpractice - Patient Received Drug Overdose After Surgery - Coma - Death - \$500,000 Confidential Settlement

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Brief Statement of Claim: The plaintiff's intestate was a 77-year-old widow with one married adult son. The deceased had recently undergone heart surgery to repair an aortic aneurysm. She tolerated the surgery well and was making a very rapid recovery.

After being transferred from the cardiothoracic intensive care unit, she received an overdose of Glyburide, causing her to lapse into a coma. She died approximately nine days later.
